

PROCEEDING OF THE GOVERNMENT OF MYSORE

ORDER NO. GAD 7 POL 69

BANGALORE, DATED 6TH JANUARY, 1970.

Kannada has been introduced as the Official Language at the Taluk Levels from 1-4-1968, and correspondence at the Taluk and Village Levels is being carried on in Kannada.

The question relating to supply of Kannada Typewriters to each Taluk has been examined in consultation with the Divisional Commissioners. In view of the progress made in implementing Kannada as official Language at Taluk Levels and in order to make the new procedure more popular and quick, it is necessary to supply Kannada Typewriters to each taluk.

After examining the question in detail, the Governor of Mysore is pleased to sanction the supply of one Kannada Typewriter to each Taluk of the District and to pay an allowance at Rs.10/-per month to the existing English Typists who should do the typing-work in Kannada. No Separate Kannada Typists in addition to English Typists should be sanctioned.

The Director of Printing, Stationery and Publications, Bangalore is requested to supply one Kannada Typewriter to each Taluk of the District on receipt of indents form the concerned Divisional Commissioners.

The Expenditure on this account will be brone from the budget provisions of the respective divisions "19,GA. E.Q.I. Taluks Establishments(C) respective divisions (4) Contingencies".
